
I am requesting funding for the City of Torrance's Temporary Housing Program in fiscal year 2023.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Torrance, CA located at 3031 Torrance Boulevard, Torrance, CA 90503.

The funding would support temporary housing in Torrance, CA. The Torrance City Council approved a 40-unit temporary housing program located on Civic Center grounds and adopted the comprehensive Plan to Prevent and Combat Homelessness on June 22, 2021. The Temporary Housing Program combines housing stability in the form of "tiny homes," and case management / housing navigation. The goal of the program is to provide participants a temporary home, while providing them with services to attain permanent housing.
