Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Pump Station Upgrade Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of El Segundo, located at 350 Main Street, El Segundo, California 90245. The funding would be used to upgrade El Segundo's antiquated storm water runoff pump station, which failed during storms in early 2024, resulting in residential flooding. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will increase the capacity to reduce flood risk and protect the residents of El Segundo.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 203 of the Stafford Act (42 U.S.C. 5133), as amended by Section 1234, National Public Infrastructure Pre-Disaster Hazard Mitigation, of the Disaster Recovery Reform Act (DRRA) of 2018.
